NEW FOREST RIDING CLUB

The club has been in existence for over 25 years. It is affiliated to the British Horse Society, the governing body of Riding Clubs in the UK. Riding Club members are also covered for £20m whilst taking part in any organised activity of any affiliated Riding Club. This cover extends from member to member. Please note that travel to and from an activity is not included nor are you covered if you are riding at non Riding Club activities. The policy also covers Employer's liability and land and access for any organised activities. Although we always hope we won't have to claim, such cover is very valuable. If by any chance you might be involved in a claim, never admit liability, never offer payment, collect witnesses' names and addresses and advise the insurer through the Club as soon as possible. **So if you have a horse, or ride one regularly, we look forward to you joining us, whether you want to compete for the Club or just meet new friends.** Just complete the form overleaf and look forward to receiving your membership card and first newsletter.
