Conditions of entry

- Entries for the Qualifiers must be made on the official Riding Club Entry Forms from www.area17-brc.org.uk/area-qualifiers and be accompanied by photocopies of horse passports to show full vaccination record. Emailed copies of passports will be accepted. The original certificates must be produced on the day.
- Each riding club making a qualifier entry must provide the names and contact details of helpers. 1 helper all day or 2 for half a day each. Details to be sent on form.
- For all test requirements please see the British Riding Clubs website at www.bhs.org.uk or British Dressage at www.britishdressage.co.uk
- British Riding Club Rules 2017 will apply
- Any protest against a decision of the judges should be made in accordance with riding club rule G14 of 2017 rule book.
- Hard hat with fixed straps (Riding Club Rules 2016) to be worn at all times when mounted.
- No horse under the age of four may compete
- No horses allowed who are not competing
- It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers and landowner and their agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, spectators, their property, servants or horses & ponies, howsoever caused on the showground
- Medical facilities will be limited to standard NHS accident and emergency call out
- Please take all rubbish home with you and pick up droppings and hay from the car park
- The organisers reserve the right to retain a proportion of the entry fee for administration purposes in the event of cancellation of the competition.
- The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers Officials and Stewards.
- Entry fees will not be returned unless a vet or doctors certificate is provided.
